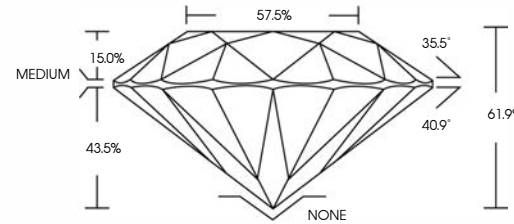

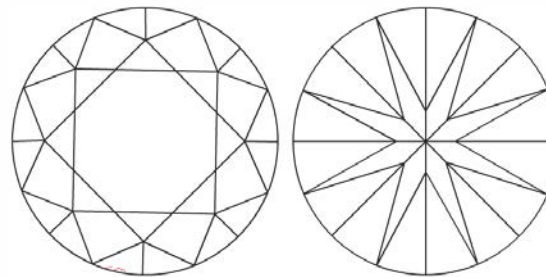

This is a manufactured (man-made) diamond produced by CVD (chemical vapor deposition) or by HPHT (high pressure high temperature) growth processes and may include post-growth treatments to alter the color. IGI employs and utilizes those techniques and equipment currently available to IGI, including, without limitation, 10X magnification, corrected triplet loupe, binocular microscope, master color comparison stones, non-contact-optical measuring device, Spectrophotometer and such other instruments and/or processes as deemed appropriate by IGI. In the case where diamond melee is set in a mounting, a random testing procedure, regarding the diamonds being of natural or laboratory created origin will be performed. This Report includes advanced security features.
